In favour: President
Bush and United Nations
strongly support Blair. Israeli officials
enthusiastic about his experience

- Opposed: Russia but Kremlin not expected to block Blair's appointment
- Unhappy: Britain's Gordon Brown, who will succeed Blair as prime minister, and EU foreign policy envoy Javier Solana oppose idea because it may draw attention away from their efforts in the region
- Palestinians: Sceptical that Blair will make any lasting difference seen as too pro-U.S. and pro-Israeli
