EU treaty timeline

Portuguese Prime Minister Jose Socrates takes over the European Union presidency on Sunday with a pledge to push through approval of a new "reform treaty" – to govern the 27-member bloc-by October

- Jun 23: After gruelling
 36-hour summit, German Chancellor
 Angela Merkel clinches deal to
 replace failed EU constitution
- Jul 23: Inter-Governmental
 Conference (IGC) to take place in
 Brussels. Groups, representing
 member states and main EU bodies,
 to begin drafting text of reform treaty
- Sep 8-9: IGC draft to be approved during meeting of EU foreign ministers in town of Viana do Castelo
- Oct 18-19: Final approval expected at Lisbon summit
- 2008-09: EU leaders to ratify treaty through national parliaments instead of referendums ahead of European parliamentary elections
