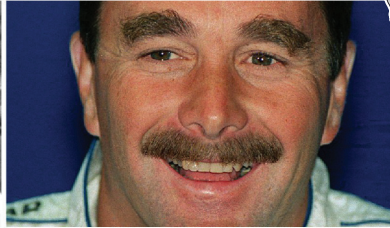


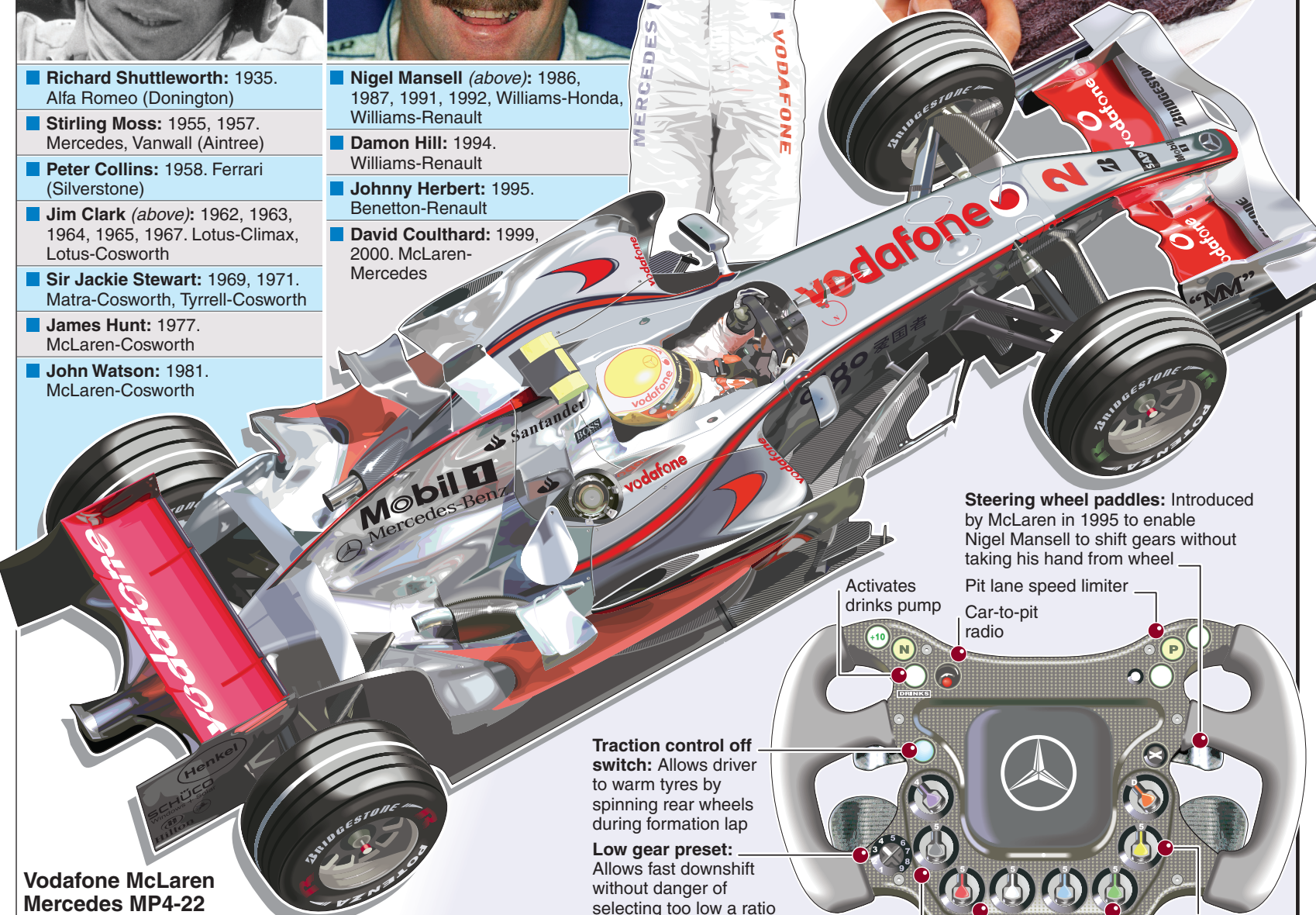
# Home-grown heroes

Lewis Hamilton is leading the Formula One championship by 14 points having set an astonishing record of finishing on the podium in each of his eight races to date. The 22-year-old is aiming to become the 12th British driver to win his home grand prix – and the 10th to do so at Silverstone

## Vodafone McLaren Mercedes MP4-22

Powered by a Mercedes-Benz FO 108T, the car typically makes 3,000 gear changes during a race

0-60mph: 2.3 seconds  
0-100mph: 3.6 seconds  
185mph to standstill: 3.5 seconds

**Traction control off switch:** Allows driver to warm tyres by spinning rear wheels during formation lap

**Low gear preset:** Allows fast downshift without danger of selecting too low a ratio and over-revving engine

**Traction control settings:** Multiple combinations enable driver to find optimum grip levels

**Steering wheel paddles:** Introduced by McLaren in 1995 to enable Nigel Mansell to shift gears without taking his hand from wheel
