

DOMINIQUE STRAUSS-KAHN

1949: Born in Paris, goes on to receive degrees in law and economics

● 1991: Named junior minister for industry and foreign trade by Socialist President *François Mitterand*

1997: Becomes finance minister in government of Prime Minister Lionel

Jospin. Reduces public deficit to qualify France for euro, and oversees part-privatisation of France Telecom
1999: Resigns after coming under official investigation in corruption

scandal. But later cleared by court

2006: Defeated by Segolene Royal
in Socialist presidential primary
