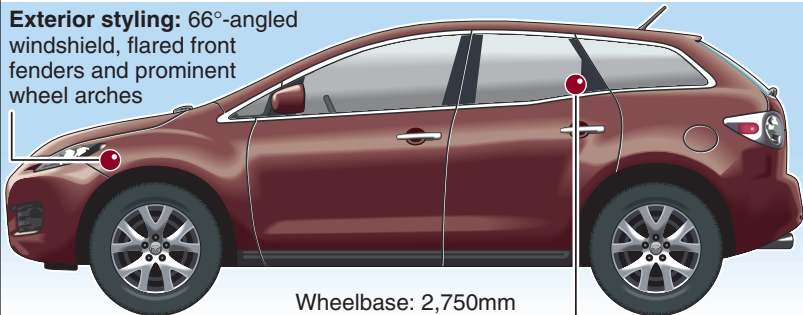


Sporty injection for Mazda's new SUV

Mazda continues the trend for downsizing SUVs with the arrival of its CX-7 "crossover". Sports car performance is delivered by a turbocharged 2.3-litre four-cylinder direct-injection engine, while a roomy cargo area retains functionality without the gas-hungry tendencies of a large SUV

Exterior styling: 66°-angled windshield, flared front fenders and prominent wheel arches



Wheelbase: 2,750mm

Interior: Sporty feel continued with leather, three-spoke steering wheel and three-gauge instrument cluster

Rear cabin: 60/40 split folding rear seats accommodate three adults or lie flat to give cargo capacity of 1,659 litres



Engine power 260bhp

Acceleration 0-100km/h in 8.0 seconds

Top speed 210km/h

Fuel economy 8.1 lt/100km

CO2 emissions 243g/km

Entertainment AM/FM/CD audio system. Optional touch-screen navigation system with voice commands and rear-view camera

Transmission: Six-speed automatic with manual shift mode. Front-wheel drive or optional Active Torque-Split all-wheel drive
