Film maestro dies



Bergman has died aged 89, at his home in Faro, Sweden. He was nominated for nine Oscars himself, while his films won the Best Foreign Film* Oscar three times

July 14, 1918: Ernst Ingmar Bergman born into devout Lutheran household in Uppsala, Sweden

Career: Begins as a script writer, Bergman directs 54 films, 126 theatre productions and 39 radio plays. International recognition comes when *The Seventh Seal* wins jury prize at the Cannes film festival
