"political alter ego' is to resign from



- 1993: Rove begins advising George W. Bush in his successful campaign to become governor of Texas ■ Election 2000: Called by Bush
- Election 2000: Called by Bush the "boy genius", his crucial strategy for victory is to target the religious right and present Bush as an alternative to scandal-dogged *Bill Clinton*
- 2002: Republicans gain seats in both House and Senate in midterm elections for first time since 1934
   Election 2004: Rove guides
- President Bush to re-election. Party gains seats in both houses of Congress for only the second time in history

  July 2007: U.S. Senate issues subpoena against him as part of probe into sacking of eight federal

prosecutors. Bush orders him not to testify, citing executive privilege
