CIA, facilitating use of Panama as centre of U.S. intelligence gathering in Latin America 1983: Becomes

country's ruler 1988: Falls out of favour with Washington as Florida court charges him with helping Colombian drug

traffickers smuggle cocaine into U.S. 1989: Captured during U.S. military invasion of Panama which kills hundreds of civilians

1992: Sentenced in Florida to 40 years in prison on charges of drug trafficking and racketeering 1999: Sentenced in absentia to 10 years in jail by Paris court on
