Nawaz Sharif - Pakistan's exiled former PM

- ◆ 1970s: Graduates with law degree from Punjab University
- ◆ 1981: Appointed finance minister of Punjab Province by military government of General Zia-ul-Hag

 1988: Benazir Bhutto becomes
- prime minister. Sharif fiercely opposes her dispute over distribution of government funds in Punjab vaults him into national spotlight
- 1990: Sharif becomes prime minister following president's dismissal of Bhutto on corruption charges
- ◆ 1990-93: Sharif's bold initiatives, including selling off inefficient state enterprises, opening stock market to foreign capital, and loosening foreign exchange restrictions win support from *World Bank* and *IMF*

- nuclear devices. After year of deteriorating relations with military, Sharif appoints General *Pervez Musharraf* as head of army
- ◆ 1999: Pakistani troops infiltrate Indian-held Kashmir leading to threemonth *Kargil conflict*. In ensuing crisis Sharif sacks Musharraf – army ousts government in bloodless coup
- ◆ 2000: Sharif sentenced to 14 years in prison for corruption, tax evasion, embezzlement, and terrorism. In deal brokered by Saudi Arabia sentence is reduced to exile
- Aug 2007: Supreme Court rules Sharif can return to Pakistan. Sharif says he will return on September 10
