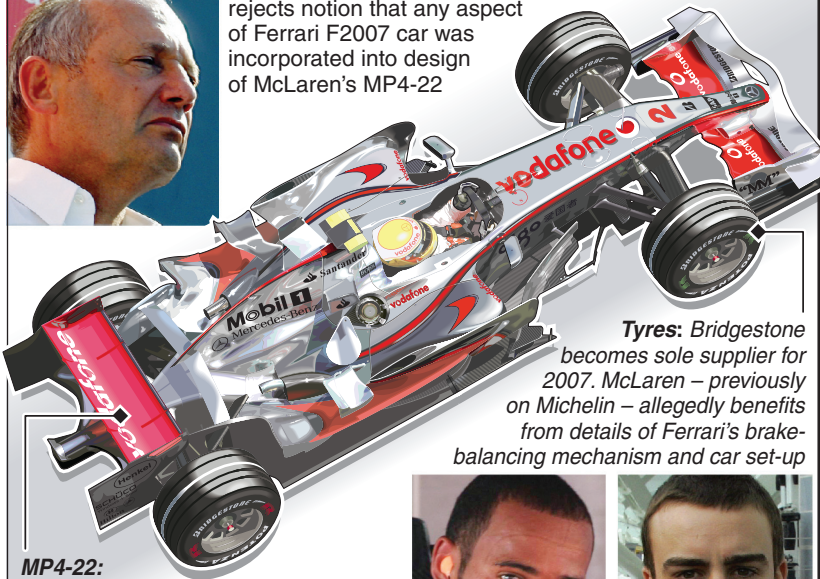
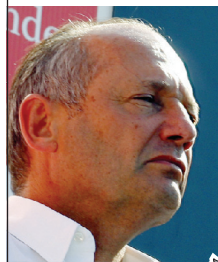


McLaren thrown out of world championship

Formula One championship leaders McLaren have been stripped of all their constructors' points, fined \$100 million and barred from scoring any more points this year. The team are accused of harnessing stolen technical secrets from Ferrari for the development of their MP4-22 car
