
Bush hosts world's worst CO₂ emitters

President Bush's policy shifts on global warming

- 2000: During presidential campaign George W. Bush opposes Kyoto Protocol on global warming
- 2001: Now President, Bush claims Kyoto damages U.S. economic interests and questions whether global warming is caused by man-made pollution
- **2002:** Distances himself from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency report linking human activity to global warming
- 2004: Bush reiterates opposition to Kyoto Protocol during campaign for second term. Calls for use of technology to fight effects of climate change

- 2005: For first time Bush accepts that "increase in greenhouse gases caused by humans is contributing to the problem" of global warming
- Jan 2007: Bush says new technology and biofuels can combat global warming
- Jun: Agrees to consider European plan to cut worldwide emissions by 50 percent by 2050
- Sep 27-28: Bush administration convenes meeting with 15 other major emitters of greenhouse gases to discuss ways to limit emissions after Kyoto Protocol expires in 2012
