

Troops sent in to crush Burma protests

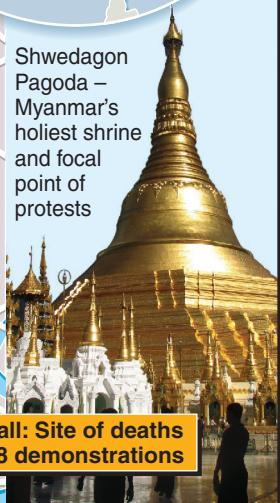
Myanmar's military rounded up as many as 200 monks in raids on Yangon monasteries in the early hours of Thursday and stationed hundreds of troops at key sites in the former capital.

■ **Wednesday:** Five protesters killed, more than 100 reported injured. Other protests in Mandalay and Sittwe

■ **Thursday:** Barricades and troops in place at Shwedagon and Sule pagodas, Bogyoke Street and City Hall – main rallying spots for protests
