- Electoral college: 342-seat National Assembly, 100-seat Senate, plus assemblies of Punjab, Baluchistan, Sindh, and North West Frontier
- Boycotts: 236 members of national and provincial assemblies plan to resign ahead of poll. North West Frontier has threatened to dissolve assembly
- Pakistan Peoples Party: Former Prime Minister *Benazir Bhutto* to hold meeting of party leaders in London on Wednesday to decide whether or not to resign from provincial assemblies
