EVENTS: Downhill (DH)
Fastest event. Each skier makes one run down steep hill, quickest time wins

Slalom (SL)
Skiers have two runs, making tight turns through course of alternate red and blue gates

Giant Slalom (GS)
Similar to slalom event but with longer course and wider gates set further apart

Super-G (SG)
Combines speed of downhill with technique of slalom on faster, more sweeping course

Combined (K): One downhill and two slalom runs
Super Combined (SC)
One downhill, one slalom run
