

# Kalashnikov AK-100 series

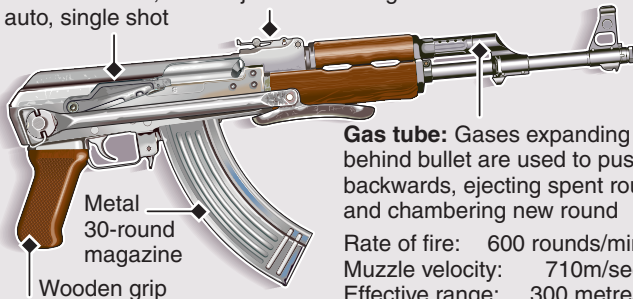

**Selector:** Safe, auto, single shot

Adjustable iron sights

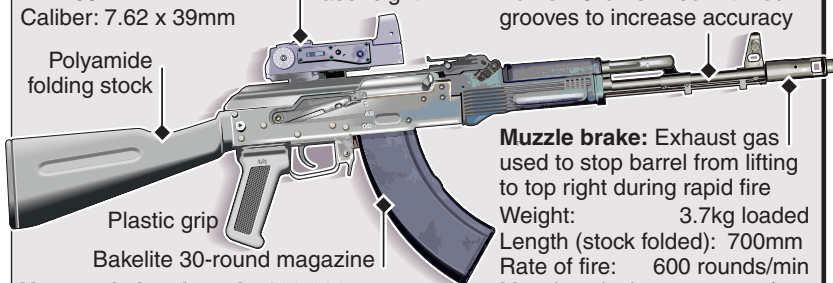

**Caliber:** 7.62 x 39mm

Polyamide folding stock

Laser sight

**Barrel:** Chrome-lined with four grooves to increase accuracy



**Muzzle brake:** Exhaust gas used to stop barrel from lifting to top right during rapid fire

**Weight:** 3.7kg loaded

**Length (stock folded):** 700mm

**Rate of fire:** 600 rounds/min

**Muzzle velocity:** 750m/sec

**Effective range:** 500 metres
