PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN EMISSIONS: 1990-2005

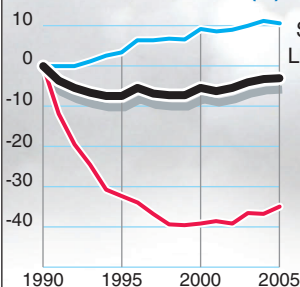

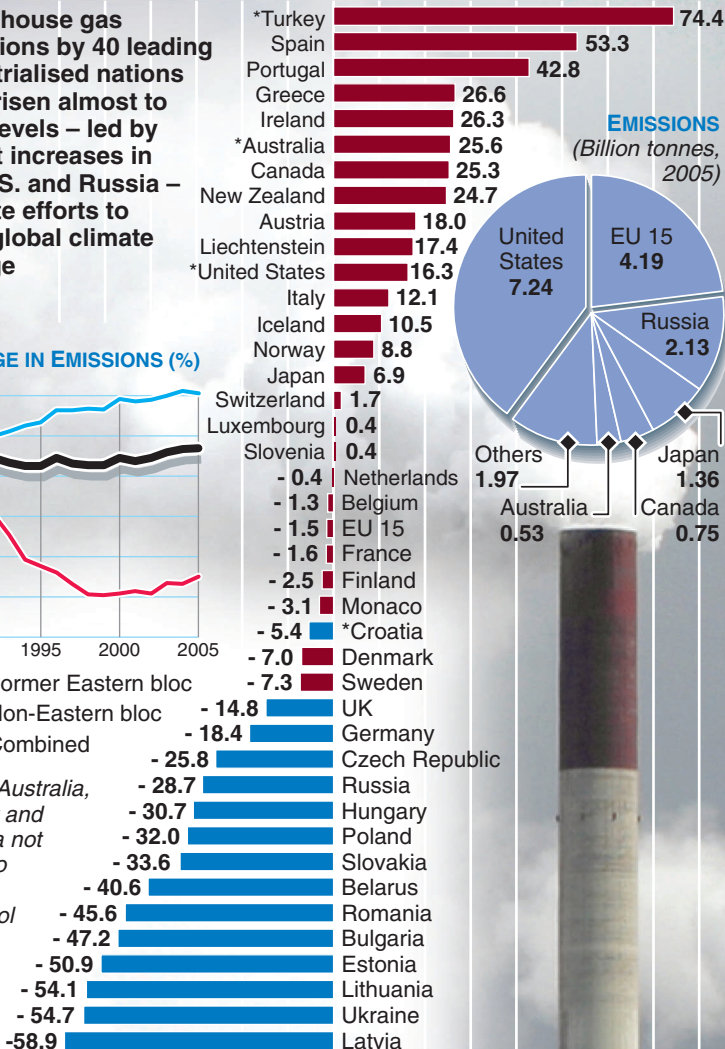
