## Who will be Russia's next president?

President Vladimir Putin's massive election victory – in which his United Russia party won 315 seats in the 450-seat State Duma – raises the question: who will run Russia after his presidency ends next spring?

Pusia will pick its candidate to replace Putin as president.

Putin could endorse multiple candidates – forcing vote to second round – to ensure successor remains dependent on his patronage



- **December 23:** Deadline for all parties to nominate candidates
- March 2: Presidential election
- May 7: New president inaugurated
