Canada, Robert "Willie" Pickton: Pig farmer convicted of murdering six

women whose bodies were butchered in his farm's slaughterhouse. Pickton

is accused of killing 26 women. Victims are among nearly 70 women who disappeared from poverty-stricken

Downtown Eastside neighbourhood of Vancouver from late 1980s until 2001

2 Russia, Alexander Pichushkin: So-called Chessboard Killer who confessed to having murdered more than 60 people, smashing their skulls with a hammer or throwing them into sewage pits after getting them drunk

3 Britain, Steven Wright: Truck driver charged with killing five prostitutes from Ipswich. All five victims were found last December


U.S., Mark Goudeau: Convicted rapist and suspected **Phoenix**

Baseline Killer. Former construction worker faces nine murder charges

U.S., Chester Turner: Pizza deliveryman sentenced to death in July for murder of 10 women and an unborn baby in Los Angeles in the 1980s and '90s

China. Hu Wanlin: Ex-convict. arrested in 1999 on suspicion of killing 146 people







have tortured, raped and murdered at least 12 young women. West committed suicide in his cell in 1995 while awaiting trial for murder

Switzerland, Roger Andermatt: Nurse sentenced to life in prison in 2005 for killing 22 elderly residents of nursing home where he worked between 1995 and 2001

Russia, Andrei Chikatilo: Schoolteacher convicted in 1992 of murdering 52 women and children in a series of cannibalistic sex crimes

Colombia, Pedro Alonso Lopez: Monster of the Andes suspected of killing 300 people in Colombia. Ecuador and Peru. Convicted in 1980 on 57 charges

Britain, Harold Shipman: So-called Doctor Death sentenced to

15 life terms for murdering elderly and middle-aged female patients between 1995 and 1998. Shipman - suspected of killing 250 people - committed suicide in 2004
