## **Treaty of Lisbon**

The European Union Reform Treaty is a slimmed-down version of the European constitution, rejected by French and Dutch voters in 2005. Due to come into force in 2009, it aims to ease decision-making in the 27-member bloc

Voting system: Number of votes allocated to members according to population size. Introduction delayed until 2014 to placate Polish fears that

Rights charter: UK to opt out of 50-article list due to concern over impact on business and legal system
