Lethal injection trial

For the first time in over a century the U.S. Supreme Court is to hear arguments about whether to ban the lethal three-drug cocktail used in most executions because it can inflict excruciating pain

THREE-DRUG PROTOCOL

1. Sodium thiopental:
Anaesthetic leaves inmate unconscious and unable to feel pain

2. Pancuronium

bromide: Paralytic

prevents
involuntary
muscle
movements.
Inmate stops
breathing
3.Potassium

3.Potassium chloride: Stops heart

Critics say that if initial anaesthetic is not administered properly, other two drugs can cause excruciating pain – but paralyzing drug would prevent any expression of pain
