
## World's cheapest car hits the road

The cheapest new car in the world, set to sell for under \$2,000, is to be launched in Mumbai. Designed and manufactured by Tata Motors of India, the "Nano" is aimed at the country's 65 million scooter riders currently unable to afford a car



Uses continuous variable transmission, lighter alternative to manual or automatic Radio, air conditioning are optional extras. No power steering, emissions control, antilock brakes, air bags, safety beams

Strong enough to drive car at 45mph, but will quickly wear out at higher speeds
