

Kenya's post-election violence continues

At least 600 people have been killed and over 250,000 displaced in tribal clashes following the disputed re-election of President Mwai Kibaki. Much of the unrest has pitted opposition leader Raila Odinga's ethnic Luos and other groups against Kibaki's Kikuyus and the security forces

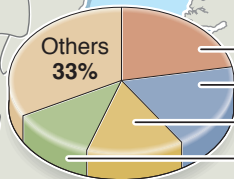
