- punitive measures after British Council re-opens both offices
- ▶ Jan 17: British Council forced to suspend operations in *St Petersburg* and *Yekaterinburg* after Council's Russian staff are questioned at length by *FSB* officers – described by British foreign secretary *David Miliband* as "blatant intimidation"
