

Hezbollah chief killed

Top Hezbollah commander Imad Mughniyeh has been killed in a car bomb in Syria's capital Damascus. Hezbollah has blamed Israel for his assassination

■ Believed to be behind kidnappings of Westerners and suicide bombings in Lebanon in 1980s, including 1983 attacks on U.S. embassy, French paratroopers and U.S. Marine barracks that killed over 350 people

■ Indicted in U.S. for hijacking of TWA airliner in 1985 (*above*), in which U.S. Navy diver was killed

■ Accused by Israel of involvement in 1992 bombing of Israeli embassy in Argentina that killed 29 people, and 1994 blast at Buenos Aires Jewish centre that killed 95

■ Featured in FBI's list of most wanted terrorists with \$5m bounty on his head
