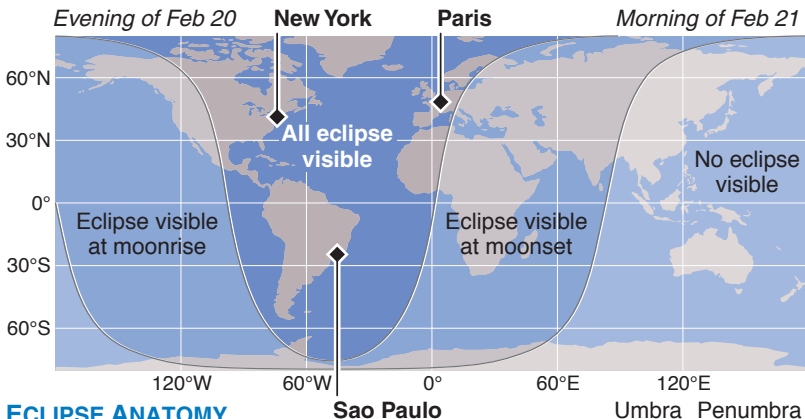


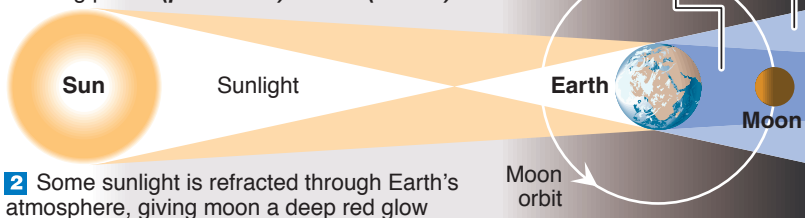
Total lunar eclipse visible Wednesday night

On the night of February 20/21, the Americas, Europe, Africa and western Asia will see the moon undergo a dramatic colour change as it enters Earth's shadow. The total eclipse starts at 03:01 GMT and lasts 50 minutes



ECLIPSE ANATOMY

1 Earth blocks sunlight usually reflected by **moon**, creating partial (**penumbra**) or total (**umbra**) shadow



2 Some sunlight is refracted through Earth's atmosphere, giving moon a deep red glow
