

"No timetable" for Turkey's Iraq incursion

Turkish officials have said there is no planned end for its week-long attack on Kurdish PKK rebels in northern Iraq, despite U.S. and Iraqi pressure to bring a swift end to the military operation amid fears it could widen into a broader conflict
