

## ► 1987: Al-Majid, cousin of Saddam Hussein, appointed governor of

northern Iraq. *Anfal Campaign* – offensive by Iraqi troops against Kurdish population – begins

▶ 1988: Orders use of chemical weapons against Kurdish village of Halabja, killing 5,000 residents

▶ 1991: Appointed interior minister to crush Shia rebellion in southern Iraq, following liberation of Kuwait by U.S.-led coalition forces

≥ 2003: Captured by U.S.-led forces after Iraq's invasion

Jun 2007: Sentenced to death on genocide charges for killing 180,000 Kurds during Anfal Campaign

► Feb 2008: Al-Majid's execution approved by Iraq's presidency
