

Tibet protests turn violent

Several people have reportedly been killed in clashes between protesters and police in Tibet's capital Lhasa. The protests, the largest in two decades against Chinese rule, threaten to cast a shadow over China's efforts to portray a unified nation in the run-up to the Beijing Olympics
