

Cash-strapped Clinton faces key primary

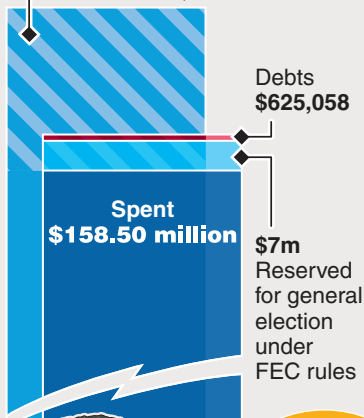
Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign has put off paying some \$8 million in bills to free up cash for the Pennsylvania primary. The Keystone State – which allocates 158 delegates – is the biggest single prize remaining in the Obama-Clinton fight for the Democratic presidential nomination

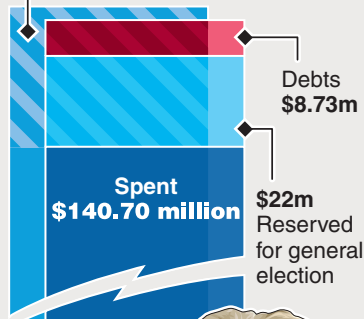
