

# C-charge key to London mayoral race

London Mayor Ken Livingstone, who is standing for re-election, plans to link the city's daily congestion charge to carbon emissions, making 33,000 motorists – one in six of the capital's drivers – pay £25 to enter central London. His main opponent, Boris Johnson, has pledged to scrap the plan
