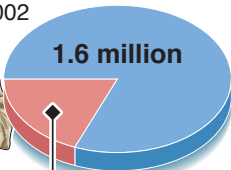


Vets mental problems

Nearly one in five U.S. troops who have served in Iraq and Afghanistan suffers from post-traumatic stress disorder or depression – but almost half of them have received no care
