- literature before career in journalism. Edits main Baath Party newspaper 1970s: Named information minister
- 1977: Joins Revolutionary
- Command Council senior Baath committee ruling Irag - becoming deputy prime minister in 1979
- 1980-88: Helps win U.S. support for Irag in its war with Iran
- 1990: Recognisable figure in world media following invasion of Kuwait
- 1991: Famously refuses to accept letter from then U.S. President George Bush to Saddam Hussein, signalling inevitability of first Gulf War
- 2003: Gives himself up to U.S. forces two weeks after fall of Saddam April 2008: Aziz goes on trial for
