

U.S. report says terrorism deaths up in 2007

Terrorist attacks claimed more than 22,000 lives worldwide last year, up from 20,872 in 2006, according to the U.S. National Counterterrorism Centre. Al Qaeda accounted for at least 5,400 civilian deaths worldwide in 2007 – of which more than 50 percent of those killed were Muslims
