

Aid delays fuel frustration with Burma junta



With up to 100,000 people feared killed in Myanmar's cyclone and an estimated one million homeless, governments and relief agencies are increasing pressure on the country's military rulers to open their borders to vital emergency aid



Yangon (Rangoon): First UN aid flights allowed to land but junta continues to deny entry of U.S. military planes and drag its feet on issuing visas for relief workers
