## Asia – natural disasters

Cyclone Nargis and the Chinese earthquake are among the most deadly natural disasters to affect Asia over the past 40 years



- hits Sichuan province in central China killing tens of thousands of people
- May 2008: Cyclone Nargis strikes Myanmar, killing more than 32,000 and leaving at least 30,000 missing
- Oct 2005: Northern Pakistan earthquake kills about 78,000 people
  Dec 2004: Indian Ocean tsunami triggered by magnitude 9.0 quake kills 230.000 in a dozen countries
- Apr 1991: Bangladesh cyclone leaves 140,000 people dead
- Jul 1976: Northeastern China 8.2-magnitude quake kills 255,000
