1859: Frenchman Charles Blondin crossed Niagara Falls on a tightrope

1908: A huge explosion, believed to be a meteorite, rocked eastern Siberia; the resulting tremor was felt as far away as central Europe

1971: The three crew members of the Soviet spacecraft *Soyuz II* died on re-entry due to a drop in air pressure

2007: A four-wheel-drive vehicle exploded at Glasgow airport after being driven into the main terminal, leading Britain to raise its national alert level to "critical"
