## Israel and Syria confirm peace talks

Israel and Syria say they are holding indirect peace talks mediated by Turkey in Istanbul, the first confirmation of negotiations between the long-time enemies in eight years

## ISRAEL-SYRIA RELATIONS SINCE 1947 1947: Syria rejects UN partition plan

- for Jewish and Arab states side by side

  1948: State of Israel proclaimed
- following end of British mandate –
  Svria and other Arab armies invade
- 1949: Israel and Syria sign armistice deal but sporadic hostilities continue
- 1967: Israel captures strategic
  Golan Heights during Six-Day War

Golan Heights repelled

- 1973: Syria attacks Israel in Middle East War. Syrian attempt to regain
- 1974: After postwar clashes on Golan Heights, Syria and Israel sign disengagement of forces agreement
- 1981: Israel annexes Golan Heights

   move not recognized internationally
- 1999: Israeli Prime Minister *Ehud Barak* and Syrian Foreign Minister *Farouk al-Sharaa* meet for highestlevel talks between both countries
- 2000: Israeli-Syrian talks on return of most of Golan Heights to Syria collapse over disagreements about whether Israel should hand back tiny

- May 21, 2008: Israel and Syria confirm indirect talks aimed at reaching "comprehensive peace agreement"
