

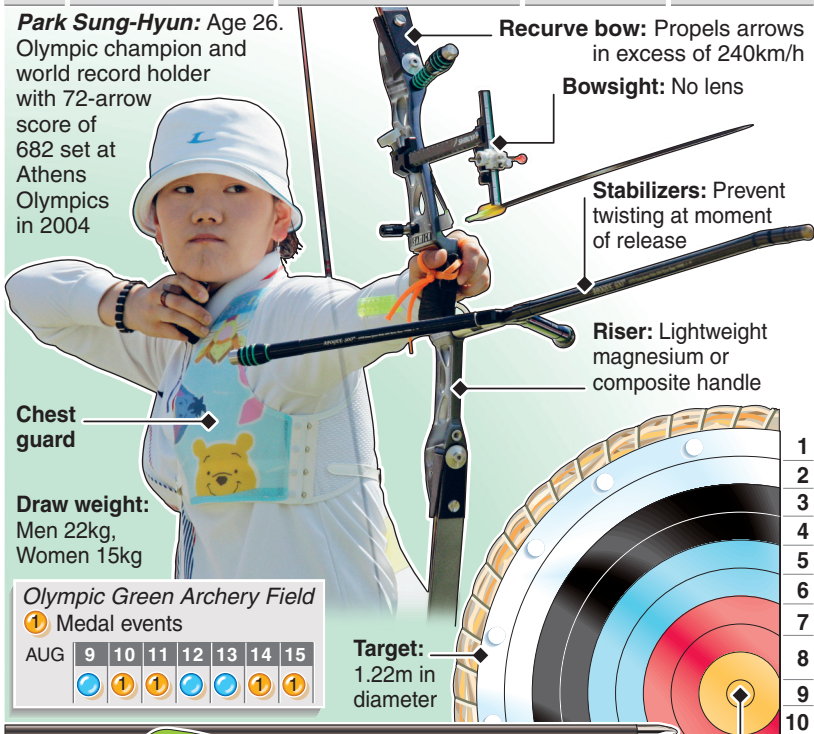
Archery – South Korean dominance continues

South Korea is the most successful nation in Olympic archery in recent years. The nation has won 14 archery golds in total, 13 of which have been won in the last five Olympics
