

Gymnasts – just five doubles in five decades

Only five reigning world gymnastics champions have clinched the double by winning Olympic gold in the men's individual all-round competition. The last person to do this was America's Paul Hamm who won gold at the World Championships in 2003 and at the Athens Games the following year
