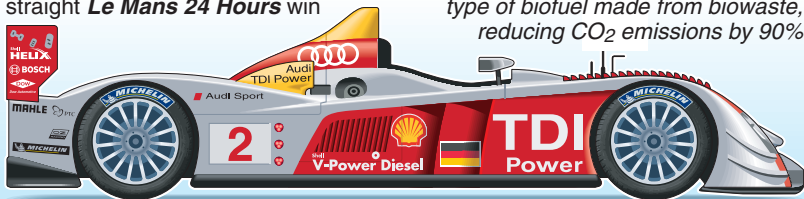


Top diesel racers return for Le Mans battle

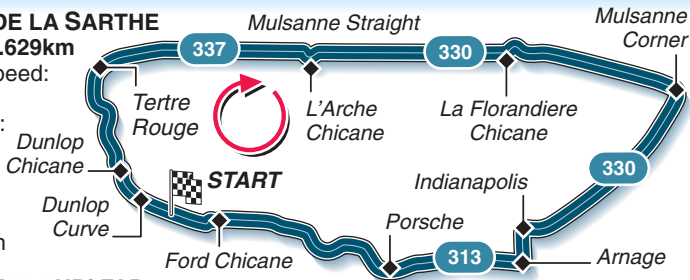
