

# Table tennis dominated by China

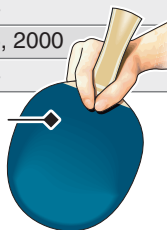
In the 20 years since table tennis made its Olympic debut in Seoul in 1988, China has dominated the event, sweeping 33 medals including 16 of the 20 golds on offer. China's long-time rival in table tennis is South Korea

**Wang Hao:** Current world no. 1, pioneer in penhold grip with revolutionary reverse backhand move

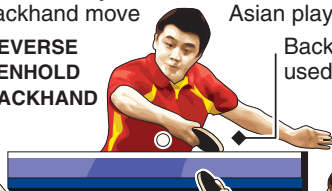
**REVERSE PENHOLD BACKHAND**

**Penhold grip:** Held like pen when writing. Favoured by Asian players

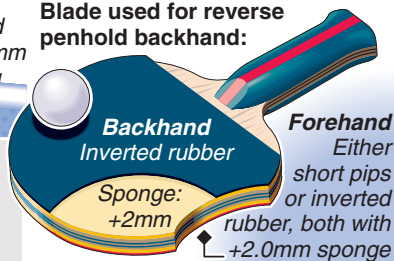


Back of penhold bat used to hit backhand

Produces heavy topspin ball with significant amount of left to right sidespin
