**480BC:** The Spartans were beaten by the Persians at Thermopylae

1965: Singapore seceded from Malaysia, becoming an independent republic within the Commonwealth

**1974:** Gerald Ford was sworn in as the 38th U.S. president following the resignation of Richard Nixon
