

Raptor – last of the Cold War warriors

The Lockheed Martin F-22 Raptor air dominance fighter is one of the last of the Cold War superfighters, designed to win control of the skies from planes like the Su-27 and Mig-29, the last generation of Soviet warplanes

F-22A Raptor: Stealth fighter evades radar detection and performs both air-to-air and air-to-ground missions

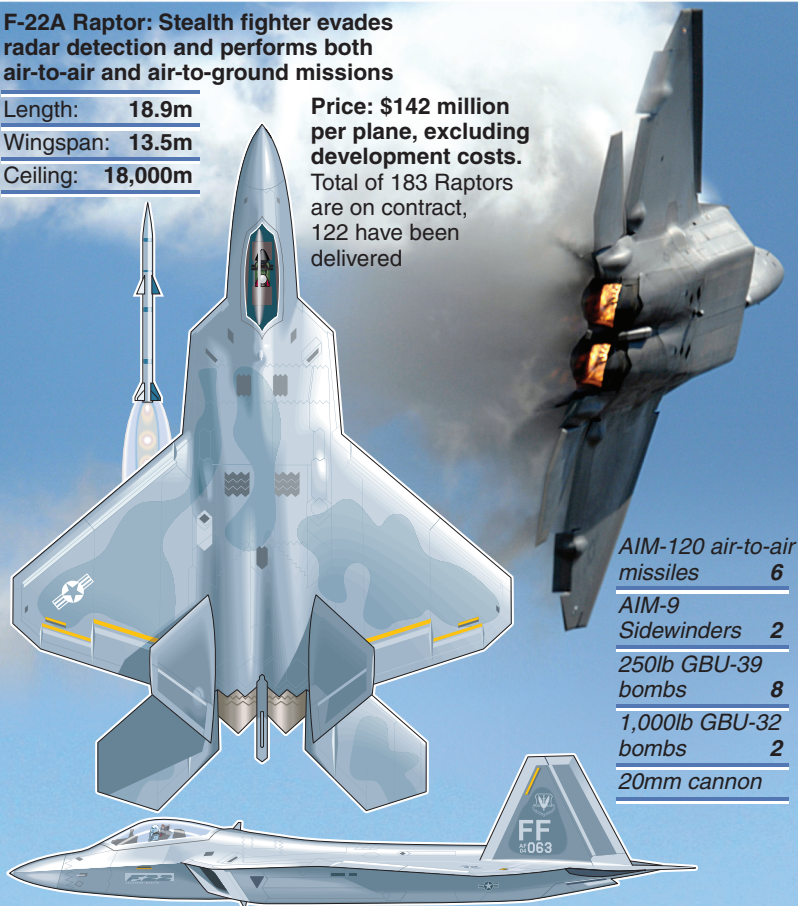
