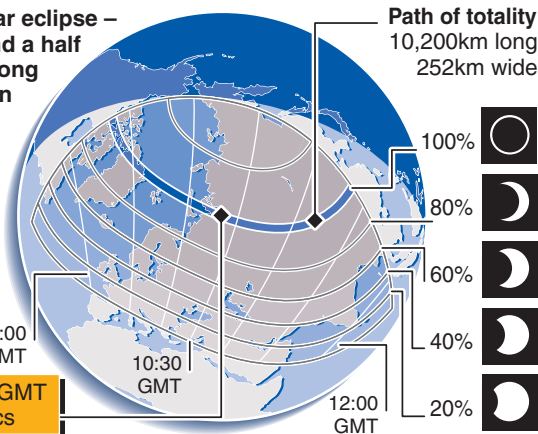


# Total eclipse of the Sun visible on Friday

On August 1, a total solar eclipse – the first in nearly two and a half years – will be visible along a narrow track starting in northern Canada and extending across Greenland, Russia and Mongolia before ending in China. Observers in north-eastern North America, most of Europe and much of Asia will see a partial eclipse
