- Gary, Indiana, seventh of nine children
- 1964: Age 6, joins older brothers in The Jackson 5: lead vocalist at age 8
- 1968: Signed to Motown Records, first four singles all reach number one
- 1982: Solo album, Thriller, released. Becomes best-selling album of all time,
- with world sales of up to 104m copies 1988: Builds Neverland ranch near Santa Ynez, California
- Case dropped for lack of evidence but Jackson settles out of court for \$22m 1996-97: Performs to over 4.5m fans

1993: Accused of child sex abuse.

- in 58 cities on HIStory World Tour **2001:** Appears with his brothers for first time since 1984 at special concert marking 30 years as solo artist
- 2005: Acquitted on fresh charges of child molestation after five-month trial Achievements include 13 Grammvs
