▲ **1829:** London's Metropolitan Police, founded by Sir Robert Peel, began the first regular patrols on the streets of the capital

**1902:** Eminent French novelist Emile Zola died

**1961:** Syria seceded from the United Arab Republic

**1992:** The first democratic elections took place in Angola after 16 years of civil war

**2006:** A Brazilian airliner collided with an executive jet in mid-air and crashed in dense jungle in Mato Grosso state, killing all 155 aboard. The smaller plane landed safely
