
Gustav shuts down Gulf oil and gas production

Almost all natural gas and oil production has been shut down ahead of the arrival of Hurricane Gustav, the first major storm threat to U.S. Gulf of Mexico energy and port infrastructure since Katrina and Rita in 2005. The Gulf accounts for 25% of U.S. oil output and 15% of gas production
