

Recent attacks on tourists in Egypt

1 Apr 1996, Giza: Eighteen Greek tourists killed, 14 wounded, in attack near Pyramids. Egypt's main Islamic militant group, **Jamaa Islamiyya**, claims responsibility

2 Sep 1997, Cairo: Nine Germans killed when their bus is firebombed

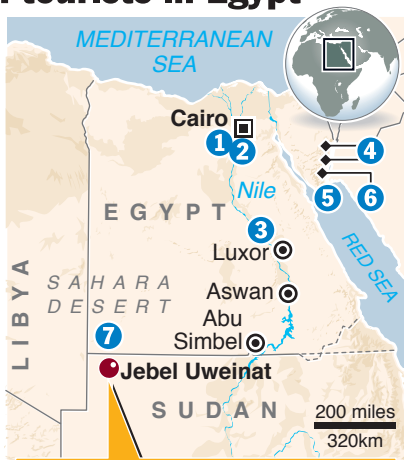
3 Nov 1997, Luxor: Sixty-two people, including 58 foreigners, killed. Jamaa Islamiyya claims responsibility

4 Oct 2004, Sinai: Bombings in Taba and Nuweiba kill 34 holidaymakers

5 Jul 2005, Sharm El-Sheikh: As many as 70 people killed in three bombings in Red Sea resort. Group linked to **Al Qaeda** claims responsibility

6 Apr 2006, Dahab: Bomb attacks kill at least 22 people and wound 150 others

7 Sep 19, 2008, Gilf al-Kabir: Gunmen kidnap group of 19 foreign tourists and their Egyptian guides
