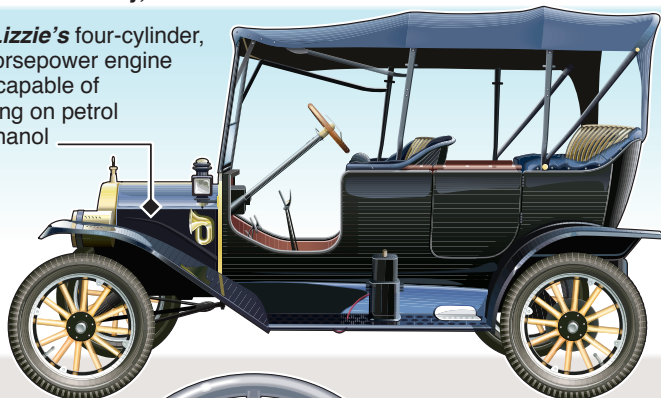


# The car that put the world on wheels

The Ford Model T – the world's first mass produced car – revolutionized the auto industry, with 15.4 million vehicles built between 1908 and 1927

**Tin Lizzie's** four-cylinder, 20 horsepower engine was capable of running on petrol or ethanol



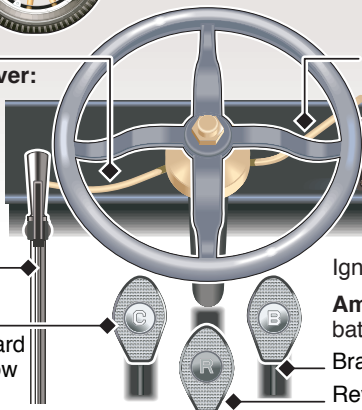
## Ignition timing lever:

Retards engine while hand cranking

Hand brake

## Clutch:

Two forward gears – low and high



**Throttle:** Up for idle (400rpm), down for top speed of 45mph

Ignition switch

**Ammeter:** Shows battery strength

Brake

Reverse gear

**Speedometer:** Available as dealer-installed extra
