EU monitors gear up for vital Georgia mission

An EU mission of 300 observers is about to start monitoring the Russian military withdrawal from buffer zones around Georgia's breakaway regions of South Ossetia and Abkhazia. Under a French-brokered ceasefire, Russia has 10 days to withdraw its forces once the EU observers are in place
